

APPLICATIONS

Lacobel glass is mainly intended to be used with **furniture**: tables, shelving units, standard and sliding doors for cupboards and wardrobes, glass display cases and bases and much more.

It can be used as a **wall covering** in a wide variety of locations (restaurants, shops, kitchens, living rooms, bathrooms and so on). Lacobel can also be used as a **writing board**, offering an infinite space for communication and creativity.

It is designed for interior use only.

LACOBEL® SAFE - extra safety

Lacobel glass also comes in a special 'safety' version: 'SAFE'. A polypropylene film - called 'SAFE' - is applied to the coated side of the glass. This film serves a double purpose:

- 1_ If the glass breaks, the shards will stick to the film avoiding injury or any further damage;
- 2_ The coated surface of the glass is protected from scratches.

MATELAC, Coloured etched aesthetic

Some AGC Flat Glass Europe painted glasses also exist in acidetched version. These are regrouped under the **Matelac range**: sophisticated glasses that create a acid-etched effect, much sought after in the furniture and shopfitting industry.
